New Life Ministries Donations

This ministry is primarily about raising up disciples of Jesus. Through Relationship with The Holy Spirit and walking in the gifts and power of God. Allowing God to work through the faith of His sons and daughters to reach the lost world. Jesus Christ, in us all, showing His love to the world through the love/unity, and the power and gifts of The Holy Spirit of God.

2 Corinthians 8 12For if there be first a willing mind, *it is* accepted according to that a man hath, *and* not according to that he hath not. **13**For *I mean* not that other men be eased, and ye burdened: **14**But by an equality, *that* now at this time your abundance *may be a supply* for their want, that their abundance also may be *a supply* for your want: that there may be equality: **15**As it is written, He that *had gathered* much had nothing over; and he that *had gathered* little had no lack.

The Lord has blessed me with employment and outside of this, the ministry is run. There is no money paid to employ anyone and so all donations reach exactly what they are intended to reach in full. This ministry thus far, is supporting our brothers and sisters in Pakistan. The simplicity of owning a bible is not even possible for most.

Thousands have no bible(bibles cost around \$7 U.S)— many wait for years hoping and many weep when they are given one.

There are many widows and orphans and families who live unable to support even basic food and clothing.

Many are forced into debt and then slavery follows. The debt can never be repaid because of expenses incurred within the slavery. Slaves are treated as possessions. Wives and daughters(as young as twelve) are treated as possessions. There are varying degrees of debt and many times daughters and mothers and families are separated from one another and sold to other factory's If a debt is paid, they are then freed. Debts generally range from \$500 to \$1200 but vary with each situation.

Once a family is freed, it is very hard for Christians in Pakistan to find employment. We are trying to provide rickshaws—three wheeled motorised vehicles, used as taxis, for the ministry to share between families, so they are able to support themselves.

We have what we call a prayer tower in Khanewal, which has a phone line for those who need prayer, or are desperate and need help. Many of our brothers and sisters are in rural areas with no way of travel. This is a vital point of contact for new and established believers to receive support and teaching in truth(not religion) and for fellowship. Through this, new churches—(small groups) are planted, encouraged and discipled to be Spirit lead—walking in the gifts—praying and expecting God is able.

Within the prayer tower is a sewing centre, whereby women and young girls, who would otherwise be forced into prostitution, or slavery are given a sewing machine, then trained for a year to make and sell clothes. This saves **young** girls from horrendous circumstances they would otherwise face. These girls also answer the calls coming in and become prayer warriors for those in need. They are discipled at the same time. They are then able to support themselves. Sewing machines cost around \$70 U.S and provide a permanent livelihood.

We have churches in Khanewal, Mian Channu, and Lahore. The Lord is bringing many pastors together in the unity of the Spirit.
